

Personal Photography on Campus: Do's and Don'ts

Do:

- ✓ Be courteous to our retail and cooperate tenants and keep doorways, stairways, and other thoroughfare clear.
- ✓ Keep your shoot small in both the number of subjects and locations as well as your time shooting on campus.
- ✓ Make sure you are staying in approved photography areas and not in areas off limits like: The Power House, tenant areas, restaurants, breweries, lobby spaces when the main lobby doors are locked.
- ✓ Make sure everyone that you are photographing wants to be photographed.
- ✓ Come with everything you need you as we will not be able to provide power or other potential needs.
- ✓ Prepare any makeup and clothing off-site. Our bathrooms are for tenant and restaurant/breweries guest use.
- ✓ Know that we consider a personal shoot anything from which individuals are not going to use the images for commercial uses (i.e. product, fashion or other marketing). If you are shooting for commercial purposes, please email julie@rockymountmills.com to discuss our policies.

Don't:

- ⊘ Shoot from the parking lot, at the Cotton Warehouse or other areas on campus that are posted with No Trespassing
- ⊘ Move interior / exterior furniture in lobbies and common spaces.
- ⊘ Bring a drone. Due to the number of people on campus everyday, we must insist there are no drones flying over campus to protect everyone's safety and privacy.
